#### Day 3: Tuesday, September 23 - Perfume Making in Grasse

- **Morning:** We'll head to the charming village of **Grasse**, the perfume capital of the world, for a **perfume-making workshop\*** and tour the town.
- **Afternoon:** Explore Grasse further, shop or enjoy a leisurely café stop before returning to Mougins.
- **Evening:** Dinner in Mougins at your leisure.

#### Day 4: Wednesday, September 24 - A Day in Monaco

### Some Questions Answered

- Our Stay in France: In Nice, we will be staying at a Hotel on the Promenade des Anglais, there are taxis shuttles available to and from the hotel from the Nice airport. (very close to the airport) We will start to gather shortly after noon on the 21st, depending on flight times. Etc. In Provence, we will be staying at a "Maison" in the town of Mougins. I suggest you add a day onto either side of this trip to make sure there are no flight delays etc. P.S. Nice is a quick flight from Paris!
- What's included in the price? Your stay in France will include 5 nights at the hotels including breakfast every morning, cocktails and dinner on our first night. It also will include day trips to the Nice Antique Market, the town of Grasse to make perfume, Antibes to shop and explore and Monaco (Monte Carlo) and more as outlined in the itinerary. (also where you see \*)
- What is the cost? The trip is priced at \$3495.00 per person double occupancy -not including airfare. The deposit is \$800. Single room for the trip is an additional \$800
- **How do I get on the list or contact you?** You will see a link for an application below, the deposit and payments can be made using our payment portal. This trip has **VERY** limited space.
- What is the rooming situation? GREAT QUESTION: The trip is priced at double occupancy but we will be able to book single rooms on a limited basis for an extra cost (see above) Let me know if you have a preferred room-mate! There is lots of common space where we will stay.
- The trip deposit will be non-refundable and we strictly require TRIP INSURANCE! You want to make sure you are covered if you have to cancel or become ill on our trip. As you know, the airlines have made it much easier to cancel your flight without penalty. As with all of our trips, if at any time you choose not to join us for a dinner or an event, that is totally fine. There will be many opportunities to paint, take photos, write and explore, always do what makes you feel comfortable.
